Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Resolution Nos. 19-059 and 19-071 of the Board of Education of Springfield Local School District, County of Mahoning, Ohio, adopted on November 20, 2018, and December 18, 2018, respectively, there will be submitted to the electors of that School District at the election to be held in the school district at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, May 7, 2019, the question of imposing an annual school district income tax on the taxable income of individuals and estates as defined in Section 5748.01(E)(1)(a) and (2) of the Revised Code, at a rate of one percent (1.00%), for the purpose of current expenses, to renew a one percent (1.00%) school district income tax for that purpose. Notice of Election on Tax Levy in Excess of the Ten Mill Limitation

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the Board of Education of the Campbell City School District, on the 23rd day of January, 2019, there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said school district at an election to be held on May 7, 2019, at the regular places of voting therein, the question of renewing an existing levy, outside of the limitation imposed by Section 2 of article XII, Ohio Constitution, to provide annual proceeds of \$989,711 for the benefit of the Campbell City School District for the purpose of providing for emergency operating requirements of the school district, at the rate certified by the County Auditor to average sixteen and three-tenths (16.3) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of tax valuation, which amounts to one dollar and sixty-three cents (\$1.63) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of tax valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2020, first due in calendar year 2021.
