State Issue 1 To require courts to consider factors when setting bail

State Issue 2 To prohibit non-electors to vote.

County Issue 3 Mahoning County Children Services renewal of 0.5 mill for the support of children services and the care and placement of children for 5 years

County Issue 4 Mahoning County TB clinic renewal of 0.1 mill for the care, treatment and maintenance of residents who suffer from tuberculosis and related diseases for 5 years

City of Campbell continuation of 1% levy on income for maintenance of parks, playgrounds and recreational facilities (1/4%) and general operation and maintenance, new equipment, extension and enlargement of municipal services and facilities and capital improvements (3/4%) for 5 years
