**VOTER REGISTRATION FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE
HELD IN MAHONING COUNTY, OHIO ON
TUESDAY AUGUST 8, 2023 CLOSSES ON MONDAY JULY 10, 2023**

You are qualified to register to vote in Ohio if you meet all the following requirements:

1. You are a citizen of the United States;
2. You will be at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election;
3. You will be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days immediately before the election in which you want to vote.
4. You are not incarcerated (in jail or prison) for a felony conviction.
5. You have not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court.
6. You have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of election laws.

For new registrations you must provide a current Ohio driver's license or state ID card number. If you cannot provide one of the above, you must provide the last four digits of your social security number.

You may request as well as return your registration form to any of the following public offices: Any county board of elections, Secretary of State, any designated agency that provides public assistance or disability programs, county treasurer, any state assisted college, public high school or vocational school, any public library, bureau of motor vehicles or by mail.

Completed registration forms must be postmarked or received by the 10th day of July, 2023. Once you become a qualified elector the board of elections will notify you of your voting location. When you go to the polls to vote or if you request an absentee ballot, you will be required to provide identification.

The Board of Elections will be open on Monday July 10, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. until
